



SPRING GIVEAWAY WIN YOUR PADDLE BOARD

RULES

CONTEST DURATION

1. The SPRING GIVEAWAY WIN YOUR PADDLEBOARD is organized by Club APRIL Marine (the "Organizer"). It will run from April 1st 8:30 am to May 31st 11:59 pm. (the "Contest Period").

ELIGIBILITY

2. To be eligible for the contest, you must be of legal age in your country of residence (the "participant"), you must be a Club APRIL Marine member with an APRIL Marine insurance policy and you must fill in the participation form. Employees of Club APRIL Marine, employees of APRIL Marine, employees of APRIL Canada, administrator of Club APRIL Marine their representatives, their agents and the persons with whom they live are excluded.

HOW TO PARTICIPATE

3. There is two (2) ways to participate:

- Complete the participation form on the French page (clubaprilmarine.ca/concours-paddleboard)
- Complete the participation form on the English page (clubaprilmarine.ca/en/contest-paddleboard)

4. Limit. There is a limit of one (1) entry per email address during the Contest Period.

PRIZE

5. **One (1) prize to be won:** the winner win the following prizes: one paddleboard, one paddle and a carrying bag valued at 500\$.

PRIZE DRAW

6. The winner will be determined by a computerized random draw from all eligible entries received. The draw will take place on June 2nd, 2022 at 12:00 p.m.
7. The odds of an entrant's name being drawn at random depends on the number of eligible entries received during the Contest Period.



TERMS AND CONDITIONS

8. To be declared a winner, the randomly selected participants must respect the following other conditions:

8.1 Being reached by email by the Organizer, the Participant must be reached in a maximum of 2 attempts, and will have a maximum of 72 hours to return the Organizer's email following the message left in their mailbox, if they don't reach out, they will lose their right to the prize;

8.2 Confirm that he meets the eligibility conditions and other requirements of these Rules;

9. Failure to comply with one of the conditions mentioned in these rules or to accept their prize, the selected participant will be disqualified. In such a case, the Organizer may, at its discretion, cancel the prize or hold a new draw until a participant is selected and declared a winner. If no participant is declared a winner within twenty (20) days of the original draw, the Organizer will have the right to cancel the prize.

10. **Verification.** The form is subject to verification by the Organizer. Any form that is, as the case may be, incomplete, inaccurate, illegible, reproduced by hand or mechanically, mutilated, fraudulent, obtained from an unauthorized source, filed or transmitted late, containing an invalid or otherwise non-compliant email, may be rejected. And will not give right, as the case may be, to an entry or to the prize.

11. **Disqualification.** The Organizer reserves the right to disqualify a person or to cancel one or more registrations of a person if he or she participates or attempts to participate in this contest using a means contrary to these rules or likely to be unfair to other participants (example: use of participation forms obtained fraudulently, registrations beyond the permitted limit). This person could be handed over to the competent judicial authorities.

12. **Conduct of the competition.** Any attempt to sabotage the legitimate operation of the contest is a violation of civil and criminal laws. If such attempts are made, the Organizer reserves the right to reject the participant's registrations and obtain compensation under the law.

13. **Acceptance of Prize.** The prize must be accepted as described in these rules and may not under any circumstances be wholly or partly transferred to another person, substituted for another prize or exchanged for cash, subject to this which is otherwise provided for in the rules of participation.

14. **Limitation of Liability - Use of Prize.** By participating in this contest, any entrant selected for a prize releases the Organizer and the persons for whose benefit this contest is held from any liability for any damage, prejudice or loss that he/she may suffer as a result of accepting or use of its price. Each selected entrant acknowledges that upon receipt of the letter confirming their prize, the performance of the obligations related to the prize becomes the sole and exclusive responsibility of the various products and service providers.

15. Limitation of Liability - Operation of the Contest. The Organizer and the persons for whose benefit this contest is held, disclaim all liability relating to the malfunctioning of any computer component, any software or any communication line, relating to the loss or absence of communication network, or in relation to any faulty, incomplete, incomprehensible or erased transmission by any computer or any network and which may limit or prevent any person from reading the rules of participation. They also disclaim all responsibility for any damage or loss that may be caused, directly or indirectly, in whole or in part, by the downloading of any Internet page or any software or other and by the transmission of any information aimed at participation in the competition.

16. Limitation of Liability – Entries. The Organizer and the persons for whose benefit this contest is held shall not be liable for any failure, for whatever reason, of the website during the period of this contest, including any damage to the computer or participant's mobile device.

17. Limitation of liability – situation beyond the control of the organizers. The Organizer and the people for whose benefit this competition is held will not assume any liability of any nature whatsoever in all cases where their inability to act results from a fact or situation beyond their control or a strike, lockout or any other labor dispute in the establishments of the organizations or companies whose services are used to hold this contest.

18. Modification of the Contest. The Organizer reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend, in whole or in part, this contest in the event that an incident or any human intervention occurs that may alter or influence the administration, security, impartiality or conduct of the contest as provided for in these rules, subject to the approval of the *Régie des alcools des courses et des jeux du Québec*, if required.

19. Termination of participation in the contest. In the event that, for any reason whatsoever, participation in the contest should end in whole or in part before the end date provided for in these rules, the draw may be made, at the discretion of the contest organizers, among entries duly registered and received up to the date of the event that terminated participation in the competition.

20. Price Limit. In any case, the Organizer cannot be required to award more prizes or to award a prize other than in accordance with these rules.

21. Limitation of liability – participation in the contest. By participating or attempting to participate in this contest, any person releases the Organizer and the persons for whose benefit this contest is held from any liability for any damages they may suffer as a result of their participation or attempt to participate in the contest.

22. Authorization. By taking part in this contest, the entrant selected for the prize authorizes the Organizer to use, if required, his name, photograph, image, voice, description of the prize, place of residence and/or declaration relating to the prize for publicity purposes, and this, without any form of remuneration.

23. **Communication with participants.** Communication or correspondence may be exchanged with participants in the context of this contest other than in accordance with these rules or at the initiative of the contest organizers.

24. **Personal Information.** The personal information collected about participants in this contest will be used for the administration of this contest and for commercial communication.

25. **Ownership.** The form is the property of the contest organizers and will under no circumstances be returned to participants.

26. **Decision of the contest organizers.** Any decision by the contest organizers or their representatives relating to this contest is final and without appeal, subject to any decision by the *Régie des alcools, des courses et des jeux du Québec*, in relation to any matter within its jurisdiction.

27. **Dispute.** A dispute regarding the organization or conduct of a publicity contest may be submitted to the *Régie des alcools, des courses et des jeux du Québec* for resolution. Any litigation respecting the awarding of the prize may be submitted to the *Régie* only for the purpose of helping to reach a settlement.

28. **Severability of paragraphs.** If any paragraph of these Rules is declared or found to be illegal, unenforceable or void by a court of competent jurisdiction, then that paragraph will be deemed void, but all other paragraphs that are not affected will be enforced to the extent permitted by law.
